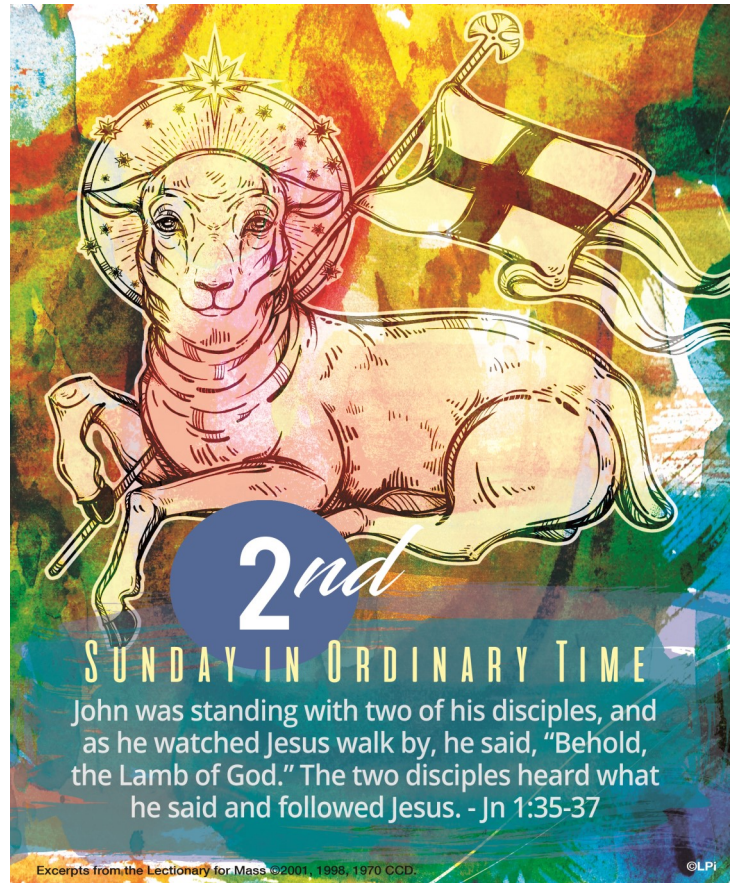

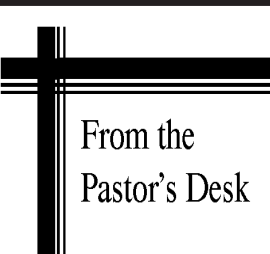


**SISTER PARISH CORNER—

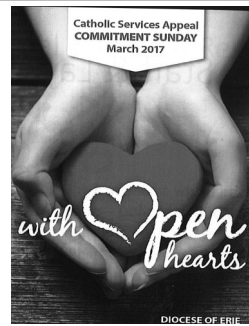
