WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

Archangels



Every September 29 the Catholic Church celebrates a feast of three archangels: Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael. The word *archangel* appears once in the Bible, in reference to Michael (Jude 9).

Tradition has added the other two names to the list because both play significant roles with him in the bible.

Raphael appears in the Book of Tobit, where he is both matchmaker and healer. Gabriel is best known for his appearances in the New Testament. He announces to Zechariah the forthcoming birth of John the Baptist (Luke 1:13, 19), and most famously he announces to Mary that she will conceive Jesus (Luke 1:26–38).

Michael appears in the Book of Daniel as a defender of the chosen people (see chapters 10 and 12). In Jude he disputes with the devil over the body of Moses. And in Revelation he and his angels fight the dragon. Michael is the patron of police and others who protect the welfare of people.

No church had ever been dedicated to Michael until the sixth century, when the faithful erected one on the Via Salaria in Rome. It was dedicated on September 29, which became the Feast of St. Michael on the Roman calendar. The other two archangels were added to this day after the Second Vatican Council. The Collect for the Mass stresses two functions of the archangels: They defend the Christian people, and they minister to God in heaven.

A fourth archangel, Uriel, is acknowledged in Christian tradition, though he does not appear in the Bible, and hence has no place on the liturgical calendar. The apocryphal gospels say he carried John the Baptist and his mother Elizabeth to join Jesus, Mary, and Joseph on the flight into Egypt. Uriel is one of the characters in Leonardo de Vinci's masterpiece, *Virgin of the Rocks*.

Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments—Diocesan Child Protection Policies: The Diocese of Erie along with other dioceses in the United States, has policies and procedures in place to address the national problem of child abuse and to aid in maintaining safe environments. The three main components of the Policy for the Protection of Children are: screening of all employees and volunteers who work with minors, training of all youth, parents, employees and volunteers, and reporting all suspected child abuse. The diocese is committed to promptly reporting any suspected child abuse directly to ChildLine or law enforcement. The diocese requires ongoing screening and training of all personnel, paid or unpaid, who have regular contact with our children and youth under the age of 18. The diocese also requires yearly safe environment training of our children, youth and parents regarding touching-safety and safe environments.


