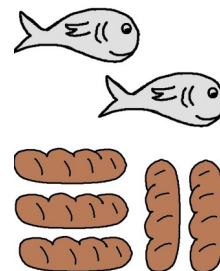

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

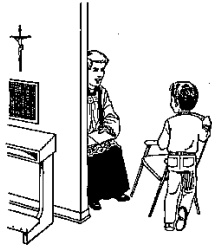


CATECHESIS

Catechesis is defined as the introduction and education in the faith to the basics of the Catholic faith for children and adults. It is the act of handing on the Word of God and teaching of the Catholic faith, which takes place from birth to death. Catechesis is never ending in a never ending relationship, we just move from a child-like image of God to a personal friendship with Him.

Catechesis begins with your child's Baptism. Catechesis begins at home while teaching your child their prayers at mealtime, at bedtime, and when taking them to Mass every week. It is not an option that we allow our children to tell us that they don't want to go to Faith Formation class. In fact, when we had them baptized we agreed to educate them in the faith that is so important to us all.

With the pandemic this year we may be looking at a different way of educating our youth in their Catholic faith. First the diocese will be giving us directions and we are to follow what our school districts are doing. With our small classes we may be able to do the social distancing and face masks. You will be given the option of teaching your child at home or bringing them to a safe environment class. Parents, you will be receiving a survey to fill out online for your input, because we must never forget you are the first and most important teacher of their faith. 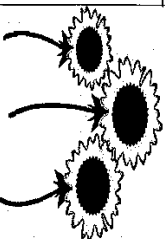
