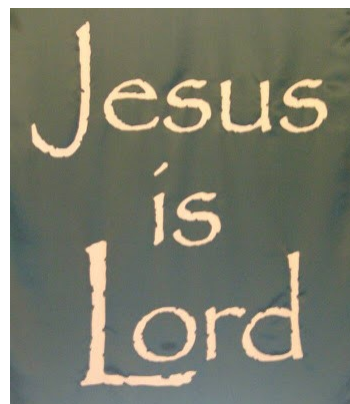

### KEEPING OUR FAITH
