WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS PENTECOST

Next Sunday we will celebrate Pentecost Sunday, which comes 50 days following Jesus' resurrection. Pentecost commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit on the disciples after Jesus' ascension into heaven. The first disciples didn't fully understand what Jesus was asking of them and it is the same for us today, we need to ask for the Holy Spirit to guide us. Pentecost always falls on the seventh Sunday after Easter. Pentecost is considered the birthday of the Christian Church.

Five of our students recently received the Sacrament of Confirmation at Our Lady, Queen of America Church with Bishop Persico confirming them with the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. We pray that the Holy Spirit strengthens these students and that they may live the Gospel and share the Good News of Jesus Christ, just as the Apostles did at the first Pentecost. If you have been confirmed, how aware are you of the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life? How often do you pray the prayer to the Holy Spirit? This is an excellent prayer for us to follow and to use for peace and serenity in our lives.

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of the faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created and you shall renew the face of the earth. Let us pray, O God, who did instruct the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant us the same Spirit to be truly wise, and ever to rejoice in His consolation.
