Today, September 18, the Church has established as Catechetical Sunday and we are commissioning our catechists at both Saint Hippolyte and Our Lady of Lourdes. Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful time to reflect on the role that each person plays, by virtue of our Baptism, in handing on the faith and being witnesses to the Gospel. The theme for this year is ***THIS IS MY BODY GIVEN FOR YOU.***

Today we will register our students and hold a meeting with parents after each Mass. We will begin classes on Sunday, September 25 and the schedule for the year will be given to the parents today at the registration meeting.

On Monday, September 26 there will be an explanation of the new *Life Teen* program (now being used for grades 6-12) presented by the Faith Formation Team of the Diocese of Erie. This presentation, offered to parents living in the Western Vicariate of our diocese, will be held at 7:00pm at St. Agatha Church in Meadville. What does Catechesis Mean? It means to echo or resound. It is the act of bringing the message of the Church to the world. So the catechist is the one who teaches in the name of the church. The parents are the primary catechists of their children, especially when they bring their child for the Sacrament of Baptism and plant the first seeds of faith in their children. The most meaningful catechesis is for our students to attend and participate in Sunday Mass. Today's second collection supports Catholic Education and half of what is collected in each parish stays in that parish for their faith formation program. For several years we have not set an annual fee for our Faith Formation program, but gladly accept donations.
