# Catching Joy

Christian Joy is a good feeling in the soul; it is produced by the Holy Spirit because he causes us to see the beauty of Christ in the world and the people we meet. (see Mt. 5: 11-12, James 1:2-3)

In Galatians 5, we find the Fruits of the Spirit which are attributes of a person living with the Holy Spirit: Love, JOY, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Faithfulness, Gentleness, and Self-control.
