## PENTECOST

Next Sunday we will celebrate Pentecost Sunday, which comes 50 days following Jesus' resurrection. Pentecost always falls on the Sunday following the Ascension of the Lord. Pentecost is considered the birthday of the Christian Church.

Pentecost commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit on the disciples after Jesus' ascension into heaven. The first disciples didn't fully understand what Jesus was asking of them and it is the same for us today; we need to ask for the Holy Spirit to guide us.

We pray that the Holy Spirit was present in a special way as our three students were confirmed on May 12<sup>th</sup> by Fr. Andrew Boyd and that they may live the Gospel and share the Good News of Jesus Christ, just as the apostles did at the first Pentecost. Those students were Dustin LeSuer, Jordyn Ploski, and Luke Sleeman. **CONGRATULATIONS!** 

If you have been confirmed, how aware are you of the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life? How often do you pray the prayer to the Holy Spirit?

This is the Prayer to the Holy Spirit that can be prayed frequently.

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of the faithful and enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And you shall renew the face of the earth. Let us pray. O God, who did instruct the hearts of the faithful by the light of the Holy Spirit, grant us in the same Spirit to be truly wise, and ever to rejoice in His consolation. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.

It has been a common practice in our parish to wear red clothing on Pentecost Sunday to remind us of the fire of the Holy Spirit.
