Teach your children to never give out personal information, such as: full name, address, phone number, email, school, or birthday on any social media site. Help your child set up strong passwords (alphanumeric) and do a yearly checkup on passwords. Adjust privacy settings for online games, apps, social media sites and your child's electronic devices. Don't forget to check the GPS settings ability to unintentionally share your child's location. Avoid using public wi-fi when sharing personal information. ## WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

### PENTECOST

Next Sunday we will celebrate Pentecost Sunday, which comes 50 days following Jesus' resurrection. Pentecost always falls on the Sunday following the Ascension of the Lord. Pentecost is considered the birthday of the Christian Church.

Pentecost commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit on the disciples after Jesus' ascension into heaven. The first disciples didn't fully understand what Jesus was asking of them and it is the same for us today; we need to ask for the Holy Spirit to guide us.

We pray that the Holy Spirit was present in a special way as our three students were confirmed on May 12<sup>th</sup> by Fr. Andrew Boyd and that they may live the Gospel and share the Good News of Jesus Christ, just as the apostles did at the first Pentecost. Those students were Dustin LeSuer, Jordyn Ploski, and Luke Sleeman. **CONGRATULATIONS!**
