#### EASTER SEASON 2024

Today we celebrate The Second Sunday of Easter or Sunday of Divine Mercy. On Holy Thursday we celebrated the Last Supper with our traditional dinner together as a parish

family and then proceeded with Mass. We presented the Holy Oils that were blessed at St. Peter Cathedral on Monday of Holy week. We then continued with the Washing of Feet and the Institution of the Eucharist, followed by Adoration until 10:00 pm. On Friday we gathered for the Good Friday Service (not a Mass) at 3:00pm to remember the Crucifixion of Christ, which represents good over evil, sin, and On Holy Saturday we gathered around the death. fire to begin the Service of Light and then into the church to commemorate the Resurrection of Christ. We welcomed Zachary Jerman into Full Communion with the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. After the Easter Vigil Mass we gathered in the social hall for our annual Break—Fast Celebration. Then on Easter Sunday we gathered for Mass to celebrate the Resurrection.

The Easter season does **NOT** end with Easter Sunday, but continues with the Octave of Easter and does not end until Pentecost Sunday.

During this time of the Easter Season we will celebrate with our First Eucharist students on April 28<sup>th</sup>. We also celebrated with our Confirmation students on March 6<sup>th</sup> at The Epiphany of the Lord Parish, Saint Agatha Church in Meadville as they were confirmed by Bishop Persico. We will conclude our Easter season with the celebration of Pentecost on May 19, 2024, as we praise God for the gift of the Holy Spirit.
