CHILD PROTECTION AND CREATING SAFE ENVIRONMENTS—Documentation for Safety: Alongside the Bishop, the Office for the Protection of Children and Youth reinforces the ongoing implementation of policies and procedures that protect children. All employees, volunteers and clergy in the Diocese of Erie who work with children must undergo criminal record checks. The diocesan Policy for the Protection of Children and Youth screening guidelines and abuse prevention training programs emphasize the importance of knowing the employees and volunteers who have access to children in our schools and parishes. Parents should remain vigilant in insisting that those with access to their children have gone through an application process and obtained the required clearances and trainings before being granted access to their children.

COMING HOME

Several weeks ago Bishop Persico absolved all from the obligation of attending the Sunday Mass. He has also opened up our churches on a limited safe distancing and amount of people who may gather in our churches along with wearing face masks. Some people are returning and are doing so in a safe manner. Others are still being careful about coming to Mass. Missing the Eucharist is the main reason people are returning and we are following strict guidelines for receiving the Eucharist.



There is concern about without regular face to face attendance, will it be easier for people to just walk away from regular attendance. The longer people stay away the easier it becomes for just not coming. We are hoping that with the gradual opening with 25 – 50 people, wearing of masks, safe distancing of 6 feet and proper cleaning between Masses with the help of volunteers will gradually bring all parishioners back to the fold. Slowly phasing back all parishioners can benefit our community spiritually, emotionally and financially.

There are several parishes in our diocese who are live streaming their Masses and we hope that if you aren't physically attending one of our Masses that you would take time for you and your family to participate in one of those Masses.
