WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

Advent is the season that begins our church year and is the time of waiting and preparation for the Nativity of Christ. This



year Advent began on November 27th and will end on December 24th.

Advent prepares us for the real meaning of Christmas and helps us to prepare to celebrate the coming of Christ. Many of us use the Advent wreath in our homes and celebrate each week. The candles represent: Hope, Love, Joy and Peace. This is the order for lighting them in your home. The Advent Wreath is one of our ways of celebrating the Advent Season; another way we follow the Advent season is with the *Little Blue Books* provided by Le Nom du Pere Society. These books are available for you at both churches in our parish.

There are many resources on-line for you to use for Advent as well. One source is from EWTN and you may access it by visiting www.ewtn.com/advent. Another on-line resource from Dynamic Catholic is *Best Advent Ever, Life is Messy*. This program features daily Gospel readings for Advent and is available at www.dynamiccatholic.com.

One of our Advent traditions for our parish is the Christ-kindel name exchange which began on Sunday, November 27th. If you do not participate in the Christ-kindel activity then we would like to suggest that you choose someone who you feel is in need of your prayers during this Advent season. Pray for them daily and send them a "thinking of you" card throughout the Advent season without disclosing your name until Christmas, just as we do for our Christ-kindel activity. This activity can be as creative as your ideas are.

Today we have come to the 4th Sunday of Advent as we meditate on the theme of "Peace." God has given us the gift of Peace so that we can live joy-filled lives. Advent gives us a chance to remember that Jesus came to bring Peace to our hearts and to our world.
