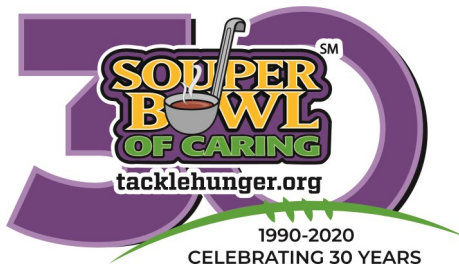

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS



Discipleship is not a one man band, but a team sport. We are all called by Jesus to be disciples and to follow him. Not only did He challenge us to follow Him but also to lead others to follow Him. Jesus has modeled for us what He calls us to do to be His disciple. The purpose of discipleship is to lead others to follow Christ by our example and following His instructions in scripture, as in Matthew 28:16-30. Following Jesus as he called his disciples to leave everything and follow Him does not mean to physically follow but by our actions show others how to follow Him in our daily lives.

- If You lead me, I will follow, Lord.
- If You lead me to glorify Your name, I will follow, Lord.
- If You lead me to preach of Your word, I will follow, Lord.
- If You lead me to show others, I will follow, Lord.
- If You lead me to use my actions of the Gospel, I will follow, Lord.
- Because You are always with me, I will follow Lord.

The words of Isaiah 43: *Be not Afraid* are based on God calling us to be disciples and leaders. He calls us within our own faith community to serve others. How easy is it for you to go forth and do God's work? Who do you know who is a true disciple of the Lord? As the song says: *Be Not Afraid*, I go before you always, Come Follow Me, and I will give you rest."

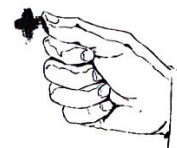
