

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST *CORPUS CHRISTI*

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) Sunday is celebrated the week following Trinity Sunday and commemorates the institution of the

Eucharist. It is a Catholic Christian liturgical Solemnity that celebrates the transubstantiation of bread and wine into the Real Presence of the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

Bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ during the Eucharistic Prayer at Mass. Belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist is central to our Catholic Faith. We find in Matthew 26: 26-28: "Take and eat; this is my body." Then he took a cup and gave thanks and said, "Take and drink for this is my blood."

Some have trouble believing that the Eucharist is truly the Body and Blood of Christ, but it is the teaching of our Catholic faith that stresses the importance of believing this about the Eucharist. When we approach the priest or the minister of the Eucharist we should look at the bread or the cup and after hearing the words *Body of Christ* or *Blood of Christ*, we respond *AMEN* with faith, joy and hope. Imagine that you are saying THANK YOU which is what your Amen means. Then take the communion with all those present around you.

At the present time, we are encouraged to take the Eucharist in the hand instead of on the tongue. Either way, we approach the minister with open hearts and hands. Many times we rush this intimate moment and do not make ourselves present to our Lord and respond in Faith as a true believer. **AMEN!**

We ask this through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.



The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity May 30, 2021

The Mystery of the Holy Trinity

"The Feast of the Most Holy Trinity leads us to contemplate the mystery of God who unceasingly creates, redeems and sanctifies, always with love and through love."–Pope Francis, May 27, 2018

The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and life. God reveals himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The doctrine of the Trinity includes three truths of faith.

First, the Trinity is One. We do not speak of three gods but of one God. Each of the Persons is fully God. They are a unity of Persons in one divine nature.

Second, the Divine Persons are distinct from each other. Father, Son, and Spirit are not three appearances or modes of God, but three identifiable persons, each fully God in a way distinct from the others.

Third, the Divine Persons are in relation to each other. The distinction of each is understood only in reference to the others. The Father cannot be the Father without the Son, nor can the Son be the Son without the Father. The Holy Spirit is related to the Father and the Son who both send him forth.

All Christians are baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. The Trinity illumines all the other mysteries of faith.

The Feast of the Visitation of Mary

Monday, May 31, 2021

This feast commemorates the three-month visit of Mary with her elderly cousin Elizabeth during Mary's pregnancy with Jesus and Elizabeth's with John the Baptist. The story appears in the first chapter of Luke's Gospel. It recounts Elizabeth's Spirit-filled greeting, acknowledging Mary as "the mother of my Lord," and Mary's beautiful response, the Magnificat, which begins, "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord." Introduced by the Franciscans in 1263, the feast became universal in the 16th century.
