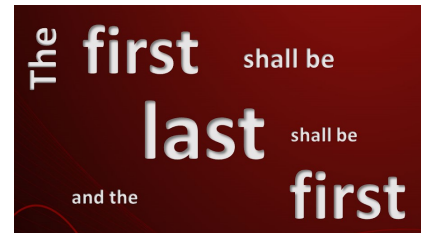

CATECHETICAL SUNDAY



The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has established today as Catechetical Sunday. The theme for this year is **SAY THE WORD AND MY SOUL SHALL BE HEALED**. Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful time to reflect on the role that each person plays, by virtue of their Baptism, in handing on the faith and being witnesses to the Gospel.

We registered our students last Sunday and we will begin classes on Sunday, September 26th. Our Faith Formation class schedule was given to the parents last Sunday at the registration session.

What is catechesis? It means to echo or resound. It is the act of bringing the message of the Church to the world. The catechist is the one who teaches in the name of the Church. The parents are the primary catechists of their children. They present their child for the Sacrament of Baptism and plant the first seeds of faith in their children. The most meaningful catechesis is by attending Mass.

Today, our special collection supports Catholic Education and half of what is collected in each parish stays in that parish for use in their Faith Formation program. Our parents are not charged a fee for enrolling their children in our Faith Formation program, but we do accept donations.

All students and catechists are to wear face masks as directed by Bishop Persico. Hopefully, we can hold our classes in-person rather than our students being home schooled like we did last year.
