

The Cochranon Ministerial Association will have a **Community Thanksgiving Service** this evening, November 21 at 7:00pm at the Christian and Missionary Alliance Church (107 S. Franklin Street). The message will be presented by the newly installed Pastor of the United Methodist Church with music presentations by Diane Kalinowski. All are welcome.

Changes to the Communion Rite: Since 2003, the posture of the people during the Communion Rite in the Diocese of Erie has differed from the practice of most dioceses in the United States. Since that time, much has changed. After much reflection, Bishop Lawrence Persico has determined that the time is opportune for us to return to the practice of kneeling after the singing of the Lamb of God. Once the people return after receiving Holy Communion, they may kneel or be seated. All will stand at the "Let us pray" for the prayer after Communion. This restored practice is intended to help to unify posture and assist those parishioners who are unable to stand for long periods of time, as well as bring our practice into union with our neighboring dioceses. Those who are unable to kneel should feel free to sit instead. This directive goes into effect the First Sunday of Advent, 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, November 27, 2021.

Our annual Advent Giving Tree will be available next Sunday at Saint Hippolyte Church. This year we will be sponsoring 5 local families. Take a tag from the tree and return the wrapped gift, with the tag attached to the gift, no later than Sunday, December 12. Boxes for your donations of non-perishable food will also be available until December 12. Thank you for your support of this project!

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS



Thanksgiving is a national holiday, celebrated on the 4th Thursday of November. Americans believe that Thanksgiving is modeled after the 1621 feast celebrated by the pilgrims of Plymouth and began as a day of prayer for the blessings and safe journey, and for the abundant harvest. A menu of turkey, stuffing, mashed potatoes, gravy, cranberries and pumpkin pie is still popular for many families. Many of these traditions had been put on hold because of the pandemic, but some are gradually going back to family gatherings and celebrations.

When we gather for Thanksgiving, what is our way of celebrating? Watching parades, football, or just enjoying each other?

Thanksgiving is still a time to be thankful for all we have and to share with those who don't have those things we possess. How many ways can you show that you are thankful? Maybe invite someone who doesn't have anyone to share the day with, attend Mass to begin the day, give food to the needy? These are just small suggestions; what can you come up with?




