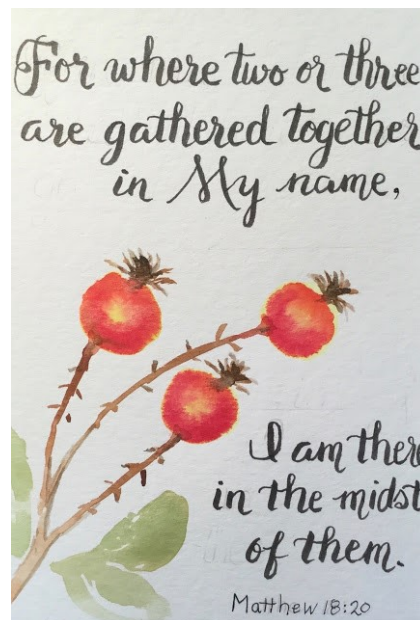

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS



With the ongoing pandemic and thoughts of not exposing our children, parents and catechists to any further anxiety, we have decided to move forward with a home-schooling program for the 2020-2021 school year for our parish Faith Formation program. We have been discouraged from using textbooks that cannot be cleansed after each class if we were to hold classes at the church.

We have ordered the *Pflaum Gospel Weeklies Faith Formation Program*. This program provides weekly pamphlets for each student which their parents or guardians can go over with them each week. This program also provides online resources for families to use on their website: www.gospelweeklies.com.

- ◆ Pre-school will use *Seeds*
- ◆ Grades K-1 will use *Promise*
- ◆ Grades 2-3 will use *Good News*, along with special sacramental materials,
- ◆ Grades 4-6 will use *Venture*
- ◆ Grades 7-8 will use *Visions*
- ◆ Grades 9-10-11 will use *Gifted with the Spirit*, with appropriate pamphlets.

We would appreciate feedback in regards to whether you are using the pamphlets and if you want to continue to use them for the school year since we need to order them in advance. The first packet of materials starts with Sunday, September 20. Other cycles begin on November 15, January 17 and March 14.

Families may pick up their first packet of materials in the Our Lady of Lourdes social hall on September 12 following the 4:30 Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes and September 13 after the 8:30 Mass at Our Lady of Lourdes, or after the 10:30 Mass on September 20 at the St. Hippolyte social hall. Other arrangements to pick up your packets can be made by contacting Joyce Tarr.

Students receive a new lesson each week which follows the three year Lectionary cycle. The lessons are revised and updated every year, which ensures that each lesson is fresh and up-to-date. There will be special classes for the Sacramental students in grades 2, 3, and 11.
