### **EDGE PROGRAM**

What is EDGE? It is a Catholic middle school (grades 6, 7, 8) youth ministry program that provides a place for youth to find a solid Catholic Community. It helps them to find answers to questions about their faith and most importantly to experience Christ in a profound and personal way. It is made up of a Core Team to assist these young students in this ministry and to present a Catholic teaching that they can understand.

Our diocese has given us new methods for forming our youth in grades 6 through 12. We are going to need a team of core people who can make the Edge program work.

The program for grades 6 through 8 is all together different from our textbook method and involves welcoming, games, fun activities, music, and, of course, discussions of our faith as they have outlined for us within each group. Every session consists of laughing, playing, and praying. The team needs to be committed and excited, love Christ and teenagers. Those who are interested in being involved with our youth in grades 6, 7, and 8 and would like to volunteer for the Core Team are asked to contact Joyce Tarr at 814-671-1009.

This year we will be confirming our students who are in the 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grades. In the following years our students will be confirmed in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade. The diocese has asked that we have sessions for the students in grades 10 through 12 which will consists of small group sharing groups.

These changes need to be implemented and accepted by our parents and students. Being confirmed does not mean that our Faith Formation is over, but a continued life in our church. To have an active program we need many parishioners to get involved and show our youth how to be a faith fulfilled Catholic and that they can be an example to all of us.
