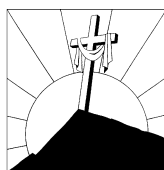

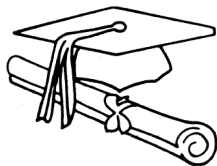

TEMPORARY HOME SCHOOLING FOR FAITH FORMATION

Families are at the center of and the most important influence for our children: personally, academically, socially, and spiritually.



We have missed the Confirmation of our 11th grade students, the 1st Reconciliation of our 2nd grade students, and the 1st Eucharist of our 3rd grade students. Until Bishop Persico opens up our Mass attendance we are asking our parents to help our students, especially the sacramental students. We will still have retreats for the sacraments, but are unable to set a date at this time.

Our parents are probably overwhelmed with academic classes for our young people with the coronavirus causing home schooling, but we would like to offer some suggestions for your child's Faith Formation.

For all of our students, we hope that you are watching a Sunday Mass as a family. The readings are listed each week in our bulletin so that you can read them together as a family and answer the *Question of the Week* according to your child's age level.

Pray the prayers for Spiritual Communion and the Pandemic Prayer from the Bishop, both of which have been published in our bulletin recently. Keep praying the Act of Contrition with your young students and praying their prayers at bedtime. 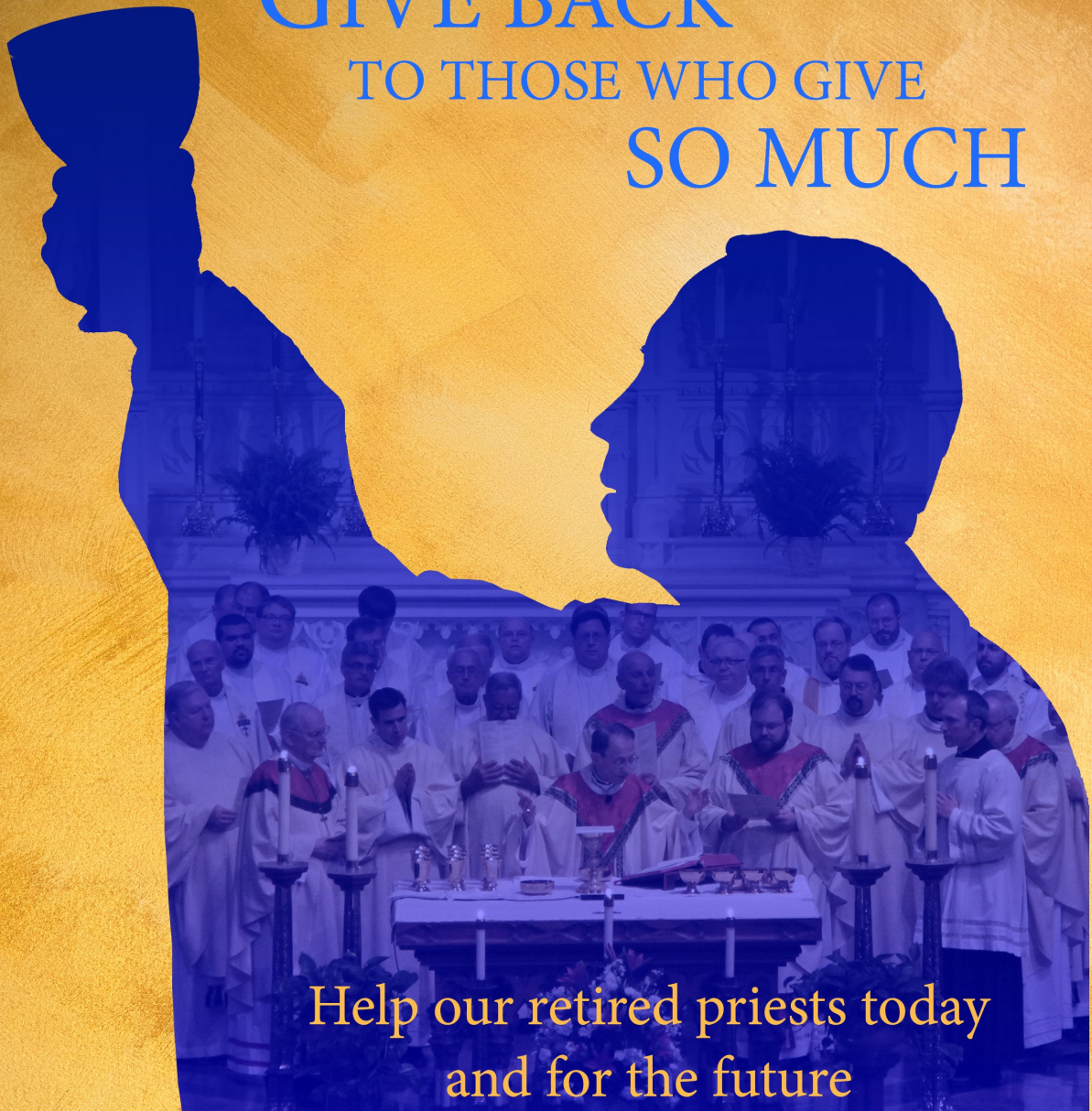
