WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS



During each Mass we proclaim the Creed, either the Nicene Creed or the Apostles' Creed. A Creed is a statement of belief of a person's faith. It is important for a person to have beliefs that they can express in their own words. It has been a practice for our parish RCIA and Confirmation Journey candidates to write a creed, in their own words, before they receive the Sacraments of Initiation.

Last Sunday the 9th and 10th grade Confirmation Journey students at St. Hippolyte worked in groups and wrote their own creed. This is their creed:

I believe in the Lord, Jesus Christ, that He created everyone equal, no matter their race, religion, etc.

I believe in the Gifts and Fruits of the Holy Spirit and the Beatitudes.

I believe that God created the universe for us to live in justice and forgiveness.

I believe that God sent His only Son to forgive our sins and save us.

I believe that God gave us Himself in the Eucharist for us to enjoy each Sunday and Holyday.

I believe that God is merciful and forgiving.

I believe that there is good in everybody, it is just that some have not been educated in the right direction and we pray for them.

I believe that God will judge us all at the end of our lives and we will rise with Him in heaven to live with Him forever and ever.

I believe that God loves us all unconditionally.




I believe in the Holy Catholic Church and all that it teaches and that I practice its teachings to the best of my ability.

I believe in God the Father, Jesus the Son, and the Holy Spirit as the Holy Trinity. Amen.
