Sharing our Catholic Faith with our Youth

The diocesan Faith Formation Team and our bishop have asked all parishes to participate in the Edge Program from *Life Teen* in order to engage our youth in grades 6 through 12. Since last year, the grade level for students to be eligible for the Sacrament of Confirmation has been in transition. This year, on May 23rd, our 10th and 11th grade students will be confirmed. Next year, the students in grades 9 and 10 are eligible for the sacrament. In 2025, all students in grade 9 may be confirmed and we will continue thereafter to confirm the 9th grade students in our diocese.

Of course, faith formation does not end after Confirmation, but continues for a lifetime! This new program provides for students in grades 10, 11 and 12 to be engaged in small faith sharing groups and they will need adult leaders. We are in need of adult Catholics who love their faith and are willing to share some time to lead these youth into becoming engaged in their faith, living as active Catholic parishioners. We need volunteers to lead these small groups of students and to be an example of what it means to be an active Catholic.

We all know that God loves us but how much do we love Him back? Are we making a difference in our parish? Are we coming forward when there is a request for volunteers?

As you can imagine, we need people to come forward to share their faith in order to keep our young people as active Catholic youth (and then adults). Who was your mentor when you were young? Who opened your eyes to know that you would remain Catholic and raise your children in the faith?

The most beneficial way to know if you should come forward and volunteer to be a mentor is through **prayer**.
