ANOINTING

Each year on a weekend in November our Parish celebrates the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick (previously known as Extreme Unction) during our Sunday Masses. This year the Sacrament will be held at both Masses on



Sunday, November 14th. The sacrament can be administered to anyone who is ill or has a condition that is in the need of spiritual or physical healing. The Sacrament of the Sick is found in James 5:14-15: *Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer of faith will save him and the Lord will raise him up. If he has committed any sins, he will be forgiven.*

The priest or bishop anoints the sick person's hands and forehead with the Sign of the Cross, as a reminder that our salvation comes through the cross of Jesus Christ and that unites us to the sufferings of Jesus. As a sacrament (an outward sign of something internal), it is performed to give God's grace through the Holy Spirit.

The anointing unites us with Christ. It strengthens us and gives us peace, and encourages us to endure our illnesses. The sacrament is administered to anyone who is gravely ill or in danger of death or if the person is to undergo surgery. The oils that are used are blessed during the Lenten Chrism Mass by the bishop and are distributed to all the parishes for use during the year for the sacraments.

Following the 8:00am Mass, Donut Sunday will be celebrated at Our Lady of Lourdes, sponsored by the Family Society. Following the 11:00am Mass, Sunday Social will be celebrated at Saint Hippolyte, sponsored by Le Nom du Pere Society. Please plan to stay after Mass on November 14 for food and fellowship.
