WHOLE COMMUNITY **CATECHESIS**

Thanksgiving is a national holiday celebrated on the 4th Thursday of November. Americans believe that Thanksgiving is modeled after the 1621 feast of the pilgrims of Plymouth and began as a day of prayer for the blessings of a safe journey and an abundant harvest. menu of turkey, stuffing, mashed potatoes and gravy, cranberries, and pumpkin pie is still a popular menu for many families.

Many of these traditions were put on hold because of the pandemic, but most have returned back to family celebrations. When you gather, what is your way of celebrating? Watching the parades, football, or just enjoying each other? Thanksgiving is still a time to be thankful for all we have and to share with those who don't have the things we possess. How many ways can you show that you are thankful? Maybe invite someone who doesn't have anyone to share the day with; attend Mass to begin the day; give food to the needy? These are just small suggestions, what can you come up with? How do we pass on our traditions?

Thanksgiving is a day to tell our family how thankful we are for their presence in our life. Thanksgiving has the power to bring encouragement to a person and build a relationship with God.

There are many scripture passages that give us verses of thanks. In your quiet time of thanks, look up some of these passages: Colossians 3:16, 4:2, 2 Corinthians 9:11, 1 Timothy 4:4-5, Psalm 106:1, 107:21, 69:30, 34:8, 86:12 and Hebrews 12:28-29, 13:15. These are only a small sampling of giving thanks found in our Bibles. What are they saying to you?

HAPPY THANKSGIVING



We should remember that the precepts of the Church are the bare minimum of what Eucharistic we need to do to be called Catholic. Hopefully we have a fire in our heart that urges us to do more out of love for God. If we do not have it, pray for that desire!

Because the third precept of the Church says to receive Communion at least once a year during the Easter season, often people thought that was all they "had to" receive it, as if it were a burden and not the spiritual remedy that it was! Various saints, like St. Francis de Sales encouraged weekly communion, and in 1902 Pope Leo XIII argued for frequent communion as a source of renewal of faith. His successor Pope Pius X argued in Sacra Tridentina that the laity should receive communion as frequently as possible. The Catechism of the Catholic Church urges us to these great heights as well: "The Church strongly encourages the faithful to receive the holy Eucharist on Sundays and feast days, or more often still, even daily." CCC 1389
