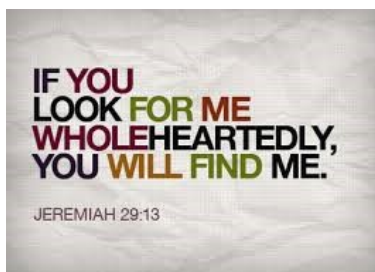

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

Lent is a time for us to re-invigorate our faith in preparation of the blessings of Easter.

As we focus on strengthening our faith, we remind ourselves daily that we need to



examine our commitment to our faith journey. Jeremiah 29:13 states: “When you search for me you will find me.” Just as Psalm 70:5 states: “May all who search for you be filled with joy and gladness in you. May those who love your salvation repeatedly shout, God is great!”

During Lent it has been a practice to make sacrifices, such as not watching our favorite television show, giving up smoking or drinking alcohol, candy, sweets, etc., so when we arrive at Holy Week we have been spiritually energized.

How are you making sacrifices this Lent? Have you attended the soup and bread meals and/or Stations of the Cross on Wednesdays? Have you made your Lenten confession? Have you been reading the *Little Black Book*? Are you praying the Rosary before Sunday Mass or after the Monday and Friday prayer services; or maybe just praying the rosary while driving or in your quiet prayer time? Have you been generous in your actions to those who need our generosity, either financially or spiritually? These are only a few suggestions.
