CHILD **PROTECTION AND CREATING** ENVIRONMENTS—Know the Warning Signs of Abuse: Those who abuse children look like everyone else. They don't look like scary people that we should know to avoid. Rather, most abusers are known to the child, such as the parent, sibling, parent's paramour, parent's spouse, other relative or babysitter. One of the most important ways to ensure the safety of children in our environments is to know the warning signs of adults who present a risk of harm to children. Among these signs are when the person (1) always wants to be alone with children in areas where no one can monitor the interactions, (2) allows children do things their parents would not permit, (3) is always more excited to be with children than with adults, and (4) discourages others from participating in activities involving kids. FAITH FORMATION 2020-2021

Faith formation for our students and adults will probably be taking on a new form and method for holding our classes and preparing for sacraments. The Erie Diocese is working on methods that would work for each unique parish situation while following the CDC guidelines. The diocesan Faith Formation Team will give us further instructions on which method will work for our parish. There will not be one particular way that will work for all parishes in the diocese and each of the Catholic schools. Each parish's Faith Formation program will need to assess their specific needs for their program and their classroom space, along with implementing new methods of educating our students in the Catholic faith. Our parish will probably be needing more volunteers to teach, monitor, clean, etc. Our parents will need to have a more active involvement with the catechesis of their children. Some possibilities which are currently being evaluated are: home schooling, Zoom classes and virtual We will be following the teaching. guides of the Diocese of Erie, whatever they may be. Of course, all of this is just in the beginning phase of planning, so depending on the status of the pandemic and CDC guidelines, we will do our best to be in compliance with the Diocese.
