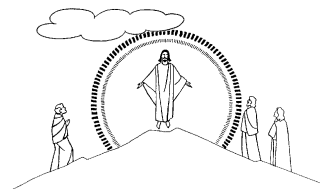

*Food For Thought
Week-end Hunger Update
July 26, 2019*

What a successful year we've had with this life-changing outreach at Maplewood Elementary School. We began on Nov 9 and ended on June 8, 2019. We started out packing 48 bags a week with 5-6 items in each bag of free food. A second Opt-In letter went out in January, and we increased to 64 bags a week. An average of 4 people a week volunteered every Thursday to pack the week-end food bags.

At Thanksgiving, Christmas and Easter Breaks, we donated extra items into the free food bags. When there was no school on Friday's or Monday's, we packed extra food items. A total of 1,753 bags were packed over 31 weeks of school for our beloved Maplewood Elementary kids. This successfully closed the 72 hours of week-end hunger for 64 children, and we want and encourage more to sign up this Fall!

We heard from teachers who noticed the difference in their classroom.

No child is turned away. If they want a food bag, they get one

We received thank you notes from kids saying thank you for the food, love the food

If there was no school on Friday, kids were asking teachers if they were still getting food bags (yes)

The financial donations generously continue to come in

We heard some heart breaking stories and many heart healing stories

We started a Summer Food Box Outreach and 26 kids were signed up. Once a month in June, July and August only, we pack 21 food items into 26 boxes and each family comes to the elementary school and picks up their box(es) of food.

There is chronic hunger in our communities, and we have all made a difference because our compassion has made the difference. Maplewood is the average community in America. Approximately 48% of our kids are eligible for the free and reduced lunch program and this is the national average across our country. When our school gets to 50%, then every student will receive a free lunch. This would tremendously help to solve the hunger gap in our communities.

*We spent approximately \$4,561.25 over the 31 weeks and approximately \$1,177 on the Summer Food Box outreach. Donation checks can be made payable to **Food for Thought**. Mail your check to: Ann Zurasky, 30935 Russell Road, Townville, PA 16360.*

Thank you for your prayers, promises and financial gifts for this outreach. We planted the seeds of compassion every week, "that we care"; and we believe there is a harvest of "good" coming for these precious children and our Maplewood community.
