WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS FAITH FORMATION IN CHRIST

Faith should be celebrated, lived and expressed in Prayer and Catechesis. When proper catechesis takes place with youth or adults, there are phases of faith formation according to *The National Directory for Catechesis*, which is published by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

Jesus formed his disciples by making known to them the various dimensions of the Kingdom of God. Christ's method of faith formation is knowledge of our faith

- 1. Faith formation is knowing of Faith and is knowing Christ in Scripture and Tradition and Creed.
- 2. Faith formation is knowledge of Liturgy and Sacraments which makes it possible to receive the Eucharist as living flesh and precious blood. In other words, believing that Christ is truly present in the Eucharist.
- 3. Faith formation promotes moral formation in Christ and encourages us to give witness both in our private lives and public lives.
- 4. Faith formation invites the Christian to live in community and to participate actively in the life of the church. To participate means to educate our children in the practices of our faith through our Faith Formation classes and participating in the life of the church.
- 5. Faith formation teaches us to pray with Christ, such as the Our Father or in a private conversation with Christ.
- 6. Faith formation promotes a missionary spirit which prepares us to be present in society. We need to witness both in word and deed. We need to evangelize like Christ, be present to the poor and compassionate in welcoming the immigrants.
- 7. Faith Formation is coming to Mass as a family or as an individual every Sunday and Holyday. This is where we experience Christ on a personal level.

These tasks make us disciples of Christ and all are necessary in developing and practicing our Catholic Christian Faith.


