### LENTEN LONGINGS

It's that time of year once again to sign up for a Lenten small group. This year we will use the program *Lenten Longings* by Catherine T. Nerney, SSJ, PH.D. from Renew International. Lent is a time to renew our faith through prayer and meditation. We discover how we find faith in Jesus through each other in Christian communities and small group sharing. *Lenten Longings* provides us the opportunity for quiet time, prayer, and sharing within our group. Groups will meet once a week for the six weeks of Lent. We ask for a donation of \$8 to cover the cost of the participant books (please don't let that stop you from joining a group if you can't give a donation; there are funds available to cover your cost).
