## WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

### ADORATION

You may have noticed on the March calendar that Fr. Dan is offering Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday at 8:00am at St. Hippolyte and on Friday at 8:00am and 9:00am and on Saturday at 8:00am at Our Lady of Lourdes. Adoration is a wonderful activity to experience as part of your Lenten devotions.

How do we spend our time in Adoration?

- Spend some time just in silence and listen to the Lord speaking to you.
- Be attentive. It is not just a time for reading; you may wish to use prayers from the parish App or a bible.
- Be Alert. Kneel or sit respectfully. If you get sleepy, stand up.
- There is no one way to pray during Adoration; feel free to configure to your needs.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to help you and then make acts of faith, hope and charity.
- Tell God how you believe, trust and love him.
- Ask for more faith, hope and love.
- Pray the rosary.
- Tell God: Oh my God, I adore Your divine greatness from the depths of my littleness; You are so great, and I am so small.

**Contrition:** Offer reparation. Examine your conscience. Imagine or look at Jesus on the cross.

**Meditation:** Contemplate God's action. Meditate on the Stations of the Cross.

**Thanksgiving:** Express your gratitude for all of God's gifts.

**Petition God:** Ask God for what you and others need. For you, your family, your church family, the world, etc.

**Final:** Make a resolution to act on a light of the Holy Spirit that you received during your prayer; something doable and checkable. Ask the Blessed Mother to help you, perhaps with Marian prayers.
