## CHRISTMAS SEASON

Today is the Fourth Sunday of Advent. During the season of Advent we as a Parish have had a prelude to the Christmas Season with our traditional \* Christ-Kindle name exchange and prayers, along with the



display of the *Journey to Bethlehem* provided by the students in our Faith Formation program under the direction of Kevin Merritt who obtains many animals from the local farmers. Many thanks to all who were involved with the production of Journey To Bethlehem, to our parish choir for their performance and to all who provided the cookies, hot chocolate and other snacks.

We begin the season of Christmas with our first Mass of the Vigil of the Nativity of the Lord on December 24<sup>th</sup> and the season extends through the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord on Sunday, January 12, 2020.

The Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord (Christmas) is a holy day of obligation, along with the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God on January 1, 2020. We celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph on Sunday, December 29. January 5, 2020 is the day we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord to celebrate the long wait of our Lord's coming. After we celebrate the Feast of the Baptism of our Lord on Sunday, January 12, the season of Ordinary Time begins on Monday, January 13 until February 25, the day before Ash Wednesday. Many people think that Christmas is over on December 26, which is not true for people of the Catholic Faith Tradition.
