### **SACRAMENTALITY**

What does Sacramentality mean?

As a noun it is basically a Roman Catholic Church sacrament—like an action, such as the Eucharist, the Cross or the use of Holy Water. As an adjective sacramentality is having the nature of a sacrament. As an adverb sacramentality in all reality is God's love poured out into each of us.

Do you practice Sacramentality?

Listed below are some examples of ways to practice Sacramentality as part of how we practice our Catholic faith.

- **Learn to forgive**—Believe that forgiving liberates not only to the other person but mostly yourself.
- **Practice Gratitude**—Everyday write a note to someone to tell them how much you appreciate them or how much you love them.
- **Demonstrate Appreciation**—Appreciate rather than criticize someone or something.
- **Give And Receive**—Accept and Give a gift from and to others.
- **Cultivate Compassion**—Generosity and letting go.
- **Honor the Sacredness** of all life. Reverence the other person.
- **Celebrate the Sabbath**—Practice your faith faithfully.
- **Parents and Guardians** – Educate your children in Faith Formation of the church.



