STATIONS OF THE CROSS

The Stations of the Cross are a 14 step Catholic devotion



commemorating Jesus' last days on earth as man. The 14 steps focus on His walk from being condemned to death until His crucifixion.

In our parish we celebrate the Stations every Wednesday at 7:00pm, alternating each week from church to church. This year we began on March 1st at St. Hippolyte, followed by March 8th at Our Lady of Lourdes, March 15th at St. Hippolyte, March 22nd at Our Lady of Lourdes, and March 29th at St. Hippolyte. Please join us in praying this wonderful tradition on Wednesday evenings. Of course, we enjoy our Soup and Bread meals at 6:15 each week before the Stations.

Stations are also prayed each week at The Epiphany of the Lord Parish, St. Agatha Church in Meadville on Friday evenings at 7:00pm.

Stations of the Cross are also offered on the television channel EWTN every day. There are also many resources on-line for praying the Stations for adults and for children, including YouTube. What a wonderful way to pray and teach your children about Jesus' last days on earth.

These 14 Stations represent the stages of Christ's passion and death:

- 1. Jesus is condemned to death. (Luke 23:20-25)
- 2. Jesus accepts the Cross. (1 Peter 2:24-25)
- 3. Jesus falls the first time. (Isaiah 53:4-5)
- 4. Jesus meets His mother. (Luke 2:34-35)
- 5. Simon of Cyrene carries the cross. (Mark 15:21)
- 6. Veronica wipes the face of Jesus. (Psalm 27:8-9)
- 7. Jesus falls the second time. (Psalm 118:11, 12-13, 18)
- 8. Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem. (Luke 23:28)
- 9. Jesus falls for the third time. (Romans 8:35-37)
- 10. Jesus is stripped of His clothes. (John 19:23-24)
- 11. Jesus is nailed to the Cross. (Mark 15:24-28)
- 12. Jesus dies on the Cross. (John 19:28-30)
- 13. Jesus is taken down from the Cross. (Matthew 27:57-58)
- 14. Jesus is placed in the tomb. (John 19:41-42)
