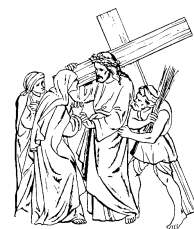

### STATIONS OF THE CROSS



One of the marvelous traditions of the Catholic Church is praying the Stations of the Cross and meditating on Jesus’ journey to the Cross. Each Wednesday during Lent our parish walks the journey of the Stations of the

Cross at 6:45pm, alternating between St. Hippolyte Church and Our Lady of Lourdes Church. We begin at 6:00pm as a family of believers with a simple meal of Soup and Bread before the Stations. It is not necessary that you come to the soup and bread social beforehand, but it sure is a nice way to build community with your brothers and sisters in Christ.

Kevin Merritt (with a few helpers) has designed a wonderful walk through of the Stations of the Cross in the basement at Our Lady of Lourdes Church and has invited the parish to participate on Wednesday, April 10<sup>th</sup> to experience this lifelike way of the Cross. Kevin has put a lot of work and time into this project and would like everyone to take the time to experience this rendition of the Stations. As we join Kevin we can enter more fully into Jesus’ suffering and walk this journey with him in a very special way. Kevin gives us some very helpful ways to live the Stations in our life:

- not to condemn others that we are judging
- not to be mean or hurt others
- to be kind to all people we meet in our daily lives and if someone falls, help them up
- to share what we have with those who don’t have
- to bring joy to all people we meet
- to keep strong in our faith
- to be forgiving when someone hurts us and not to hurt others
- to be thankful that Jesus died for us on the Cross
- let us always remember to see everyone we meet with love, mercy and hope.

If you have not been able to participate in the Stations of the Cross each week you can still walk them on your own time as there are several materials that are available on the internet or at church.

P.S. Don’t forget the Penance Celebration today at 4:00pm at Saint Hippolyte Church. This is another great tradition of our Catholic Faith.
