Faith formation basically is equipping people to live as disciples of Jesus. Faith Formation can mean anything from religious education classes to helping at the church dinners, or anything that forms Christian Community or makes us a vibrant parish. Faith Formation is not just classroom lessons; it is based on the components of **Worship**, **Knowledge**, **Community** and **Service**.

When the Pastoral Planning process for the Diocese of Erie began, the one area that Bishop Persico said was different from the other areas of planning was Faith Formation. It differs from the others in that we need a new passion for the Gospel and to form a better understanding of what it means to be a disciple of Jesus. It was that planning process which led to the hiring of a diocesan Faith Formation Coordinator, Deacon Steve Washek, to assist the parishes in establishing a lifelong Faith Formation of parishioners; not just for the religious education of students, but a program for our entire lives.
