## WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

### FRUITS OF THE SPIRIT

“In the same way, every good tree bears good fruit, but the bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a bad tree bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Thus you will know them by their fruits.”

*Matthew 7: 17-20*

This passage from Matthew helps us to understand the Fruits of the Holy Spirit, which are the behaviors of people, and allows us to practice them in our lives. The fruits of the Spirit are:

- Charity—giving help to those in need.
- Joy—feeling happiness and spreading joy to others.
- Peace—freedom from disorder in our lives.
- Patience—tolerating suffering without getting angry or upset.
- Kindness—the quality of being friendly, generous and considerate of our brothers and sisters in Christ.
- Goodness—the quality of being morally good and virtuous.
- Generosity—the quality of being generous with what we have to help others.
- Gentleness—the quality of being forgiving rather than angry or to be gracious rather than vengeful. The gentle person acts more like Christ.
- Faithfulness—living our life in accordance to God’s will.
- Modesty—to humble yourself according to being gifts from God.
- Self-control—to exercise moderation in all things.
- Chastity—to remain sexually pure until marriage.

These spiritual gifts are a good guide for how we are to treat others and remain true to our faith.

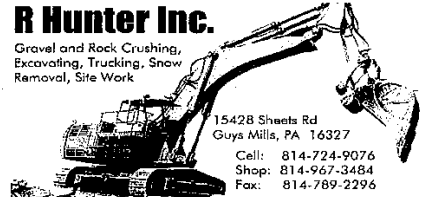
