**The Rosary will be prayed this week** on Tuesday at 6:30pm at Our Lady of Lourdes. All are welcome to join us in prayer.

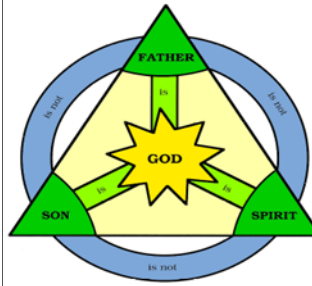

## WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS



Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. What does that mean to us?

Trinity Sunday, as it is more commonly known, is the celebration of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit in one God and is our central belief

about God. Trinity Sunday is celebrated on the Sunday following Pentecost (50 days after Easter) and has been celebrated as early as the 10<sup>th</sup> century.

The doctrine of the Trinity is one of the central beliefs about God. God came to us in a threefold figure: first as Father and Judge, as revealed in the Old Testament; second as the Lord in the Incarnate Figure of Jesus Christ; and third God lived among us as the Resurrected One in the Holy Spirit.

Trinity Sunday teaches us about the oneness of God in His three forms of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. It celebrates a doctrine rather than a figure or an event. The Trinity is not present in Scripture, it is totally a matter of faith and trust.

On Trinity Sunday Christians show their love for and faith in the Trinity by praising and giving glory to God, by attending Mass and by singing and praying while at Mass. Trinity Sunday is also celebrated in all of the western churches (Latin, Catholic, Anglican, Lutheran, Presbyterian, and Methodist). In the Catholic Church, today is fittingly known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity.
