

### **HAVING DIFFICULTY PAYING YOUR HEATING BILLS?**

Additional federal funds have been released for the LIHEAP/CRISIS Recovery Program to help those in need during this difficult time. These funds are available to those who are income eligible and have a past due heating bills. Crisis Recovery funds are also available to qualified customers who may be experiencing a heating emergency. A family of four with a gross annual income of \$38,625 qualifies for a grant. When you apply you will need the following: names of people in your household along with their date of birth and social security number; proof of income for all members; a past due heating bill.
