But the truth is, we must. You see, our diocese still has work to do on behalf of the Lord. The church needs your help to remain focused on Christ and the needs of the people of God.

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS CONFIRMATION

Although Confirmation is sometimes called the "sacrament of Christian maturity," we must not confuse adult faith with the adult age of natural growth, nor forget that the baptismal grace is a grace of free, unmerited election and does not need "ratification" to become effective. St. Thomas reminds us of this:

Age of body does not determine age of soul. Even in childhood man can attain spiritual maturity: as the book of Wisdom says: "For old age is not honored for length of time, or measured by number of years." Many children, through the strength of the Holy Spirit they have received, have bravely fought for Christ even to the shedding of their blood.

Catechism of the Catholic Church # 1308

The Sacrament of Confirmation is one of the seven sacraments of the Church and the third Sacrament of Initiation into the Catholic Church; the other two are Baptism and Eucharist. The Catholic doctrine states that the Sacrament of Confirmation enables the faithful to be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit, which then strengthens us to live a Christian life.

In our diocese the Sacrament of Confirmation is administered to 11th grade students. Bishop Persico has given us directions to provide a full confirmation process for students in the 9th, 10th, and 11th grades. Therefore, here in our parish we call this process their Confirmation Journey.

The Bishop is the ordinary presider over the Sacrament of Confirmations for our 11th graders. At the Easter Vigil the priest may administer the Sacrament of Confirmation to the newly elect as well as Baptizing them through the RCIA process at which time they will also receive the Eucharist. These are all the Sacraments of Initiation.

Our 11th grade Faith Formation students will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation on May 9, 2019 at Our Lady, Queen of Americas Church in Conneaut Lake with Bishop Persico. Please keep them in your prayers as well as the other sacramental students in 2nd and 3rd grades. On the bulletin board at each of our parish churches is a prayer partner sign up sheet with the names of our students so that you can pray for them through their final sacramental preparations this year.
