- 8. Go fishing (or just play a round of the card game Go Fish) in honor of St. James the Apostle who was a fisherman. His feast day is July 25th.
- Plan a visit (or video chat, if distance is an issue) with grandparents to celebrate the feast day of Sts. Anne and Joachim, grandparents of Jesus. Their feast day is July 26th.
- 10. St. Martha used hospitality as a way to serve Jesus and others. Prepare a meal or treat for someone special. Her feast day is July 29th.
