TRADITION

What is Tradition? Tradition is a passing down a custom through generations. The Annual Frenchtown Ham or Chicken Dinner has a long tradition of serving people since 1888. This year is the 124th time for the event, which is taking on a new look due to Covid-19 and will go through another change by serving the food as carry-out only. We have been working on the logistics of drive up service with pre-orders only.

Our first dinner was held under the direction of Rev. Eugene Cogneville in 1888. We took a break from the annual dinner for a few years during World War I and World War II, but it always came back. We've had many different menus, from Chicken Fricassee to chicken cooked in homes of parishioners and then just Ham due to the department of health stating that we couldn't cook the meat at home. The present method of cooking was changed in 1977 under the direction of Fr. Richard Mayer when we built the current barbeque pits. Our menus has remained the same since that time, with Barbequed Chicken or Ham along with Mashed Potatoes and Gravy, Green beans, Applesauce, Coleslaw, and Pie or Fruit for dessert.

Traditionally this event has always been held on the last Sunday in July at St. Hippolyte Church. This event benefits both St. Hippolyte and Our Lady of Lourdes Churches and is the largest fundraiser we have for our Parish. This year our committee decided to continue with the dinner, with new guidelines in order to carry out our long tradition on the last Sunday of July. The menu will remain the same, but with a different style of serving.

If you have not called Julie Foulk (814-789-3688) to volunteer, please do so. All workers will be required to follow the CDC and PA Department of Health recommendation of wearing a mask to protect one another.

Remember to follow the Golden Rule: "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you."

RESTRICTIONS OF THE USE OF OUR SOCIAL HALLS have

been eased up a bit. We are allowing use of the hall, but renters must follow the current guidelines of no more than 50% occupancy (which would be 150 people). All social distancing rules apply and all surfaces must be disinfected as part of the cleanup process.
