WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

SACRAMENTS OF SERVICE

No single characteristic is more identified with Catholicism than its rich worship and sacramental system. We have shared information about the Sacraments of Initiation in the past few weeks, today we will look at the Sacraments of Service: Marriage and Holy Orders.

Jesus valued marriage and prayed that nothing would destroy the union of love that Christian Marriage celebrates. The Catholic church remembers that value and celebrates the permanent union of man and woman in the Sacrament of Marriage. The marriage is not a sacrament if it is performed outside of the Church. If you are planning a wedding it is necessary to contact the parish priest to make arrangements for the sacrament at least 6 months in advance.

The sacrament of Matrimony or Marriage signifies the union of Christ and the Church. It gives spouses the grace to love each other with the love with which Christ has loved the Church; the grace of the sacrament thus perfects the human love of the spouses, strengthens their indissoluble unity, and sanctifies them on the way to eternal life.

Jesus also recognized that some people have a particular role to play in the life of the community of faith, a role of leadership and of a particular kind of service. Catholics call that sacrament Holy Orders, the special anointing of the priesthood.

The whole Church is a priestly people. Through Baptism all the faithful share in the priesthood of Christ. This participation is called the "common priesthood of the faithful." Based on this common priesthood and ordered to its service, there exists another participation in the mission of Christ: the ministry conferred by the sacrament of Holy Orders, where the task is to serve in the name and in the person of Christ the Head in the midst of the community.
