#### **Dear SMS Families**,



### You're invited to the Synod!

Pope Francis has called the Church to a World-Wide Synod. The "Synod on Synodality" has begun, and the Church wants to hear from every baptized person. Why? To develop the practice of becoming a "listening Church," one that effectively journeys with its people.

**Who is invited to participate?** All people of goodwill, Catholics who practice the faith or not, and everyone in between. Deacon Marty Aubel and Deacon Frank Luciani will be facilitating the listening sessions where you will be invited to pray together for the coming of the Holy Spirit, then offered time to share your thoughts for the Synod. **When & Where?** There will be 3 in-person meetings in March. Pick a time/date convenient for you and **pre-registration by Feb 26 is needed to attend**.

**What will you be asked to share?** The Synod is an opportunity for people to evaluate how the church and our parish are doing in terms of living out the Gospel message that Jesus entrusted us with. There are things we are doing well and need to keep doing and things that have not gone quite as we had planned or hoped and can do better. So, pray about what you will share in this process. We want to hear your stories about how we ARE meeting your needs specific to your life circumstances, how we are NOT meeting

your needs specific to your life circumstances, and about how is God speaking to you and through whom or in what way. Your thoughts will be compiled into an overall report to the Diocese. The Diocese will gather information from all its parishes and forward it to the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops. They will gather it from across the US and forward it to the Vatican. Every country in the world will be participating in this same process. The final results and the Pope's direction on all this information will be published in 2023. - Hope to see you! • After careful consideration and discussions with our Wellness Committee, Fr. Christopher, and other principals in our diocese, we are updating our face mask policy. Starting on Monday, February 28, face masks will be HIGHLY RECOMMENDED in school (especially for those who have health issues), but NOT MANDATED. - Please be on the lookout for COVID symptoms in yourselves and your children. If you suspect any symptoms, please have your child or you tested. In order to maintain a safe environment for all, please practice and help your children practice COVID protocol: proper mask wearing at all times, social distancing, and frequent hand washing with warm soapy water. If your child is sick, please keep them at home!! Kindly contact the school if you or your child does develop any symptoms and also check with your child's doctor for next steps. Talk with your doctor and your child's doctor about whether the COVID vaccine is right for you and your child. COVID vaccines are available now for children ages 5-12. Speak with your child's pediatrician about the right decision for your child.

**THIRD WEEK:** We live in a world where people who look, sound or act differently are often treated unkindly. <u>MAKE IT</u> <u>YOUR BUSINESS TO BE KIND</u> to people who are different than you.

FOURTH WEEK: We may not be thankful for our many blessings, like our food, home, family, friends, freedom... Choose a favorite charity that helps those who are not blessed as we are. <u>Donate ONE COIN</u> for each of your blessings to that charity. It helps others so much!

**FIFTH WEEK:** We are such 'busy' people: we work hard, run errands, do household chores, we even play hard! Let's step back each day this week from our 'busy' times and <u>give a little of our time to God, in prayer.</u>

**SIXTH WEEK:** We tend to forget about people we don't see much of: people who live in nursing homes, in prisons, in hospitals, in group homes and in institutions. <u>Remember, they are God's children, too!</u> <u>They need our prayers, our help, our visits, and our love!</u>
