

St. Catherine of Siena (1347-1380) Feast Day: April 29th For centuries, people have drawn inspiration from the words of St. Catherine of Siena, the 14th century Dominican tertiary (third order) and Doctor of the Church who worked tirelessly for its reform and to move the papacy back to the Vatican from Avignon.

From hundreds of letters and prayers to her spiritual testament "The Dialogue" (composed of four treatises), her writings are classics and have been translated from Italian into many languages.

Perhaps her most famous quote is: "Be who God meant you to be and you will set the world on fire."

From "The Dialogue:"

"Love transforms one into what one loves." Dialogue 60 "You are rewarded not according to your work or your time, but according to the measure of your love." Dialogue 165

From her letters:

"God is more ready to pardon than we have been to sin." Letter T343

"Consider God's charity. Where else have we ever seen someone who has been offended voluntarily paying out his life for those who have offended him?" Letter T345
