Once the people return after ceiving Holy Communion, they may kneel or be seated. II will stand at the "Let us pray" for the prayer after ommunion. This restored practice is intended to help nify posture and assist those parishioners who are unable stand for long periods of time, as well as bring our actice into union with our neighboring dioceses. Those ho are unable to kneel should feel free to sit instead. This irective goes into effect the First Sunday of Advent, 4:00 .m. on Saturday, November 27, 2021.

Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments

Digital Behavior: Parents create trust with children by initiating open, honest discussions. These dialogues are an opportunity to communicate values and expectations about vour family's appropriate digital behavior, including viewing or sharing content, and apps they can and cannot use. Check in frequently with your children about their digital experiences to address any potential risk of cyberbullying and harm. Be clear that your intention is to look out for their well being, and that you want to have an open dialogue. Listen to their concerns and express your perspective. To minimize the risk of cyberbullying or harm from digital behavior, parents can: set clear expectations about digital behavior and online reputation, educate about the harmful effects of cyberbullying, posting hateful speech or comments, sexting, and sharing naked photos of themselves or others (including potential legal issues), be clear about what content can be viewed or shared, and identify which apps are appropriate for your child's use and which are not. Establish rules about the amount of time that a child can spend online or on their devices. Model positive, respectful digital behavior on your own devices and accounts.
