Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner



The last two bulletin articles have reflected upon Bilbo's fearful soul. The image is that he lives in a hobbit hole (like many of us). We all have tendencies of taking the comfortable route, the "I'm going to be in control at all costs" route. Yet, this "hobbit hole" approach to life simply does not lead to adventure, joy, or purpose.

Bilbo begins to think about Gandalf's offer "Would you like to go on an adventure?" Then we read these words, "Then something...woke up inside him, and he wished to go and see the great mountains, and hear the pine-trees and the waterfalls, and explore the caves, and wear a sword instead of a walking-stick."

Let me be very clear: we are built for change, challenge, and adventure. We are built to tackle opportunities and overcome the odds. It's something remarkably unique about being human. It's also something remarkably unique about hobbits.

Even though Bilbo spent his entire life avoiding changes and challenges, there is still something deep within him that desires changes and challenges. Of course, that's the biography of many of us.

The rest of the book is all about Bilbo's adventure. He experiences joy, mission, and happiness like never before. He learns an incredible amount about himself. Even better, he forgets about himself because he's focused on others.

Next week I will reflect on the last paragraph of the book.

All are welcome to enjoy a concert to celebrate the most recent improvements to the "Historic Hook and Hasting" pipe organ at St. Catherine of Siena Church. Under the direction of Stephen Paul Toney, the concert will feature members of both the Queen of the World Church, St. Marys, and St. Catherine Church with sacred music and organ solos. Stephen Paul has been restoring this magnificent organ, originally from Boston, Mass., for posterity for the past 14 years. It is the instrument he learned to play organ music, he said, and he has a special connection to this organ.

The most recent work done to this pipe organ was reinstalling the missing concussion bellows on the great division wind truck. He also restored the reeds on the organ which included the trumpet great division and coropean and oboe on the swell division. 
