Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner

I attended a conference a few years ago on evangelization. I will never forget what the presenter said within the first few minutes. He stated, "If you really want to be a good evangelist, know the census data in your region. Know the statistics. Know everything you can that is objective. Never settle for your experience or for the experiences of those around you."

Now, the presenter did not mean that an evangelist should not consider peoples' experiences. He was simply stating that objective knowledge of a region must be studied and then paralleled with peoples' experiences (including one's own experience).


There are a few reasons why that presenter's statement is dead right. First, faith builds upon reason just as grace builds upon nature. Effective evangelization, therefore, is built upon reason and nature. That which is objective and encompasses something far beyond what one's limited worldview and life experiences can achieve is a best friend to an evangelist. Experiences are very helpful but our worldviews are limited. Therefore, data (such as census data concerning age, religious preferences, employment, ethnicity, etc.) help to build an evangelization approach upon something objective. An evangelist must study the data, listen intently to the experiences of the people, reflect on one's own experience and then effectively evangelize with a keen awareness of the culture. -Fr. Ben Daghir
