Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner

I hear people say, "I can't stand New Year's resolutions." I also hear others state, "You know, I kind of need something like a resolution each year." Maybe you find yourself in one of these camps or you are neutral on the topic...but I doubt you are neutral because you are human. Let me explain.

The idea of a "New Year's resolution" is very interesting to me because it speaks about something much more fundamental than a cultural phenomenon. A New Year's resolution speaks to us being made in the image and likeness of God. Here's why...

Our minds are built for the truth. Our wills are built for what is good. Our passions are built for beauty itself. St. John of the Cross once stated that the human soul is like an infinite cavern. In other words, the human soul can never be filled up with things of this world. Nothing in this world ultimately makes a human being happy. We are made in the image and likeness of God who is infinite and perfect. This is precisely why St. Augustine, in his autobiography entitled *Confessions*, can state "My heart is restless until it rests in Thee."

With this theological perspective in mind, we now return to New Year's resolutions. It's clear, at least from my young mind, that people yearn for more, seek improvement, don't settle for mediocrity, and are hungry and thirsty for much more than food and drink.

The New Year's resolution is not some corny and secular phenomenon. Instead, it is a reflection of something very peculiar to the human race. We find ourselves in a finite world yet we desire the infinite. We find ourselves imperfect yet we desire perfection. We find ourselves within space and time yet we desire eternity. We want to resolve this tension.

Therefore, we make resolutions. Maybe we Catholics should be careful in downplaying New Year's resolutions. If I'm not mistaken, we often say in confession "I firmly resolve with the help of Your grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin." Maybe resolutions are part of the journey of grace. Maybe the culture is right. Maybe the Catholic Church is right too. Maybe we all need to make a few resolutions during this new year.
