Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner

We hear in today's Gospel that Joseph "did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him." One of St. Joseph's titles is "terror of demons." Here's why: Joseph, without hesitation, consistently does the Lord's will. Despite the fact that he doesn't see the entire plan of God, he humbly accepts his role in this great adventure.

Pope Francis has often referred to St. Joseph as a "father in the shadows." The pope's insight refers to St. Joseph's willingness to do the behind-the-scenes work. St. Joseph consistently sacrifices for Mary and Jesus. He figures out the travel arrangements, he protects them, he takes care of the food, he figures out the lodging, he guides them away from Herod's wrath, he stands behind them as the shepherds and magi greet Jesus, etc.

St. Joseph's entire life, therefore, was at the service of Jesus and Mary. He served the King and the Queen of the Universe. He did so quietly, consistently, and humbly. He did so in the shadows and without recognition. Why did he do so? The Lord commanded him. And this, of course, terrorizes the demons. Fr. Ben Daghir

The Polish Oplatki Wafers will be available Monday - Thursday from 8 a.m. - 2 p.m. at the




