Bishop Robert Barron stated “‘God has no grandchildren.’ Each generation must meet Christ and the Church for the first time, not relying on mere cultural ambience or ethnic identification” (Foreword to the book RETURN).

These words speak volumes about our current situation. If I had a dime, or even a nickel, for each time a parishioner has said to me, “When I was a kid there were so many more Catholics...” I’d have some serious cash.

Clearly, the cultural ambience and ethnic identification is no longer a motivating factor in our region. This is not anything new, it’s been going on for decades.

Catholicism must be modeled, expected, proposed and not imposed, and joyfully encountered. There is a reason why the Catholic Church has consistently stated that the parents are the primary educators of the faith. This is because Catholicism is passed down from one generation to the next. Bishop Barron is correct, God does not have grandchildren.

In other words, it takes a tremendous amount of work to pass on Catholicism to the next generation. It takes all of us from a variety of angles, perspectives, examples, and opportunities.

It takes exactly what Jesus said it would take... one’s heart, mind, body, soul, and strength.
