

Deacon Ben's Corner

"What is it like being a deacon?"



Several parishioners have asked me, "What is it like being a deacon?" I think this is a great question. My answer is that the primary task of the deacon is to assist the priest with the Eucharist - especially in the distribution of Holy Communion. The Eucharist strikes at the core of being a deacon. It's a very powerful experience to be

next to Msgr. Siefer as the bread and wine is turned into the body and blood of Christ. It's also a very remarkable experience to distribute communion, to be face to face with parishioners, and the realization that they are receiving Christ himself. There's really nothing more remarkable than this experience and it's often too easy to miss the mystery. Believe me - I often miss the mystery. I thank God quite often that I am a few feet away from Msgr. Siefer at the altar. I'm a normal, young guy - it's easy for me to get distracted. God's grace works in remarkable ways though - being a deacon has helped me to focus on the Eucharist, parishioners, scripture, and my own inner voice. Such is the power of grace. - Deacon Daghir
